



11 Acoustic receivers ('listening stations') deployed March 2014 (N.B. two in Vasse River not shown)




Busselton High School Year 9's April 4th - one Bream (nicknamed "Fluffy") acoustically tagged + 4 T-bar tagged



Total Sea Mullet acoustically tagged = 5 (size range 265 - 300 mm TL)
